Bachar Houli OAM is a former Australian Rules Footballer, most notably having played for the Richmond Football Club, and famously known as the **first devout Muslim** to play the game at the highest level.

He forged a remarkable career at 'Tigerland', playing over 200 games and becoming a key part of a three-time winning premiership side (2017, 2019, 2020).

Off the field, Houli is a devout Muslim and the founder of the Bachar Houli Foundation. Houli is regarded as a leader and role model for the Australian Islamic community due to his inspiring work in promoting social cohesion and harmony. Houli's dedication and commitment to his community work with Muslim youth has enabled him to become one of Australia's most prominent public figures.
