



Al Siraat College Uniform Policy

All students attending Al Siraat College are required to wear a school uniform and uphold the guidelines for appearance, all of which are maintained by the Islamic Tradition.

The Al Siraat College uniform is an essential element in creating a sense of belonging and identity. We regard grooming and uniform as basic matters of self-respect and respect for the school community. Students are expected to wear the appropriate school uniform with pride at all times, including excursions.

If a student has a reason for not wearing the uniform on any given day, s/he must bring a note from home. Middle Years and Senior Years students must obtain a Uniform Pass from The Markaz without which, a detention will be issued. Consistent breaches will result in parents being contacted to either immediately rectify the issue or take their child back home until it is rectified.

Responsibilities

All members of the College community have an important role and responsibility supporting the successful implementation of the College Uniform Policy.

College

The College is responsible for ensuring that the Al Siraat College Uniform Policy is accessible to all members of the College community.

Students

Students are responsible for wearing their full correct uniform on the appropriate days and adhering to the required appearance guidelines.

Parents

Parents are responsible for their child's uniform and are expected to check that it is being worn correctly before the child leaves home for school. Students who are unable to wear the correct uniform at any time must present an explanatory note from their parent/guardian to The Markaz at the beginning of the school day. This note should explain the reason for the student not being able to wear the appropriate uniform. Parents must also ensure that their child's appearance adheres to the guidelines laid out by the school.

Teachers

Teachers are responsible for being familiar with the Al Siraat College Uniform Policy and enforcing it.

Guidelines

Presentation

Student uniforms must be clean and ironed. It is essential that students take pride in their presentation as they are not only representing themselves but the College community and the Muslim Community in general.

School Shoes

Black leather (or leather like) shoes must be worn. Black sport shoes are not permitted as a part of the regular uniform but may be worn with the sports uniform.

School Bags

Students must only bring Al Siraat College school bags to school. The older navy Al Siraat College school bags may still be used.

Undergarments

Students may wear light coloured undergarments to keep warm but it must not be visible. Long sleeve garments may not be worn under short sleeve tops.

Maroon, black or white loose legging must be worn by girls. Printed and colourful pants or PJ pants are not acceptable.

Make-up

Make-up and nail polish are not to be worn.

Jewellery

Visible jewellery may not be worn, e.g., bracelets, rings. (with the exception of a wristwatch).

Facial Hair

Male students are encouraged to grow a full beard. Beards must be well maintained; no goatees or stylised beards are allowed.

Hair Styles

Hair colour should be no other than your natural hair colour. Colouring, including partial and 'streak' colouring are not permitted.

Attention seeking, prominent 'fade' style hair (mushroom-style, mullet, undercut, crew cut, number zero, shaved head, layers, sparkly hair, spiky hair etc.) is not permitted. Hairstyles

should be short, simple and conservative. Hair must not reach the collar at the back. Ears should be visible and a fringe should not reach the eyebrows. Hair must be neatly combed.

Students who consistently wear their Sunnah cap, jubba and do not shave their beards may request to grow their hair longer. These student requests may be considered for approval by the relevant Head of Year.

Students who do not comply will go through the following steps:

- a) Be given a 1 day grace period to fix their hair
- b) Disallowed from class if they do not comply, until they get their haircut

Uniform Requirements

The Boys' regular uniform consists of:

- Black trousers
- White shirt (long or short sleeves) or white kameez OR
- Optional fully white jubba (full-length sleeve; length below the knee but above the ankles; no slits on the side)
- Black weather proof jacket and/or optional black jumper
- Black or white socks
- Black leather (or leather like) shoes (*not black sport shoes*)
- Sunnah cap (highly recommended)
- Black school bag with logo
- Optional plain black beanie (cold weather)
- Optional plain black neck scarf (cold weather)

The Girls' regular uniform consists of:

- Summer Dress for Terms 1 and 4 (Foundation to Year 6): Ankle length
- Maroon tunic with white blouse (Foundation to Year 12): Ankle length OR
- Maroon skirt with black blouse (Years 7 to 12): Ankle length
- Skivvy: Plain white T-shirt OR plain white shirt with long sleeves (*no prints*)
- Leggings: Maroon, black or white (*no tights/stockings*)
- Maroon weather proof jacket and/or optional maroon jumper
- Black or white socks
- Black leather (or leather like) shoes (*not black sport shoes*)
- White scarf – One piece pull-on for Foundation to Year 4
- White scarf for Years 5 to 9
- Black scarf for Seniors (Years 10 to 12)
- Black school bag with logo
- Optional plain black neck scarf (cold weather)

Sports Uniform

Students are permitted to come to school in their sports uniform on days when they have Sport classes allocated.

The sport uniform for all students consists of:

- Black tracksuit pants (summer or winter)
- Black and gold short sleeve for boys
- Long black and gold polo with long sleeves for girls
- Sport Jacket
- Black or white socks
- Sport shoes

Students must be in either FULL sport or FULL regular uniform

The Uniform Shop

The school uniform shop is located at the College. You will find it opposite the main car park and next to the new green TEAMS building. It is inside the small beige brick building and has its entrance from the alleyway at the back.
