WHEN DOES RAMADAN START?

Al Siraat College Musalla follows moon-sighting, and Ramadan commenced Sunday 3 April 2022.

WHAT TIMES WILL PRAYERS BE?

Isha prayer will start at 7:45pm, and Taraweeh prayers will follow straight after.

IS REGISTRATION REQUIRED TO PRAY?

No, there is no need to register to pray in our Musalla.

ARE WUDU FACILITIES AVAILABLE?

Yes, wudu facilities are available, however we recommend performing wudu at home.

DO I NEED TO WEAR A FACE MASK?

No, face masks are not required, however it is recommended.

DO I NEED TO BRING A PRAYER MAT?

No you don't need to, but you are welcome to if you prefer.

IS THERE A SPACE FOR SISTERS TO PRAY?

Yes, we have arrangements for sisters in the prayer hall with no children, and another space available for sisters with their children.

CAN CHILDREN ATTEND PRAYERS?

Children can attend with their parents, and are to be supervised during the whole prayer time.

Boys can join their fathers or guardians in the brothers section of the Musalla.

Girls and young children can attend with their mothers or guardians in Building B Assembly Room.

WILL IFTAR BE HELD EACH DAY?

Yes, iftar will be available each day, and everyone is welcome to join.

We have separate iftar for brothers and sisters.

For those attending iftar, we kindly request they bring a plate of food to share.

SHOULD I BRING MY OWN DRINK BOTTLE?

Soft plastic disposable bottles are very noisy and disturb salaah, and we encourage everyone bring their own reusable drink bottle.

DO YOU NEED VOLUNTEERS?

We would be very grateful for any volunteers, particularly for set up for iftars, and clean up afterwards.

WHERE CAN I PARK?

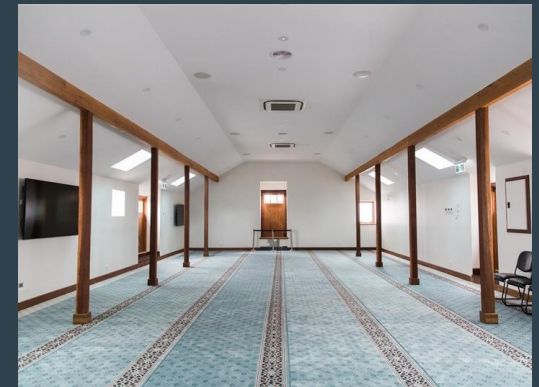
Parking is available on school grounds, either in the carpark through the front gates or in the service lane outside the front of the school.
